

# CCSD15 DISTRICT HEALTH REGULATIONS



## MEDICATIONS AT SCHOOL

The administration of medication to students during school hours is discouraged unless absolutely necessary for the well-being of the student. In accordance with the Illinois Department of Human Services & State Board of Education, the policy for the administration of medication during the school day is as follows:

- ◆ A **Medication Administration Form** is required for all medication, including over-the-counter medication. Download form @ <http://www.ccsd15.net/AboutDistrict15/DistrictOffices/HealthServices/>
- ◆ Medication must be in the original container and appropriately identified and labeled.
- ◆ Medication is administered under the supervision of the registered nurse at school.
- ◆ Long-term medication requires annual renewal orders.
- ◆ Medication with the exception of asthma inhalers & epi pens is stored in the health office.



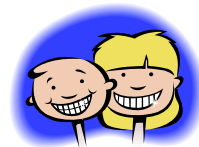
## KINDERGARTEN EYE TEST

Because most classroom instruction is supplemented with visual aides, Illinois law has always addressed the vision needs of students. Besides the yearly screening of students for vision deficits, there is a law requiring that **all students entering Kindergarten have an eye exam** before starting school. According to Illinois School Code, the Proof of the *Vision Exam* must be provided to school.

Please arrange for your child's eye appointment and request a copy of the **Vision Exam**. Return the copy of the **Vision Exam** to the school health office after the exam.

## DENTAL EXAMINATIONS

Although regular dental care is encouraged for **all** children, **a dental examination is a requirement for Illinois students in kindergarten, second, and sixth grades.**



According to Illinois School Code, the **Illinois Department of Public Health Proof of School Dental Examination Form** must be provided to school by **May 15.**

Please arrange for your child's dental appointment and bring the attached *Proof of School Dental Examination Form* to the appointment. Return the completed form to the school health office after the exam.
